Where are your offices located?

The Parks & Recreation office is inside the AJ Smith Recreation Center which is at 810 N. Evans in Tecumseh. The building is between Burt St. and Macon Hwy.

Can I rent a room at the Hayden-Ford Mill (formerly the Community Center)?

We no longer rent rooms at the Hayden-Ford Mill. This is now home to J. Trees Cellars, the Tecumseh Senior Center, and the Fitness Connection. We do rent a room at the AJ Smith Recreation Center. More information is available under Forms & Documents on the left side menu and then click on the AJ Smith Recreation Center Room Rental Agreement. You may also call the department at 517-423-5602 for more information.

Can I rent one of the park shelters?

Yes, we do rent shelters at Cal Zorn, Aden Mead, Satterthwaite, Hotrum/Promenade, Adams Park, and Tecumseh Park (aka the pit). Please call us for pricing and availability at 517-423-5602.

I would like to coach my child's team. Is there anything I need to do to be able to coach?

We truly appreciate our volunteer coaches! Before you can coach you do need to complete two things. First, is the Background Check Information sheet. This is located under Forms & Documents. Then you also need to watch the Head's Up Concussion Video. You can access that by clicking the link on the left titled MI Sports Concussion Law. Then on that page viewing the Youth Sports Training video. Please note this video does not play well on the Chrome browser. You also cannot skip ahead in the video. Once you've watched the video you will need to print the certificate and bring it to the Parks & Recreation office. In appreciation we will give you half off your child's registration for the program once you have completed the above steps.

I signed my child up for a program awhile ago and haven't heard from a coach. What should I do?

You can expect to hear from a coach the week prior to the start of the program. If you have not heard from a coach by the start date of the program call the department at 517-423-5602.

My child is enrolled in a Tot program and I haven't heard from a coach. What should I do?

All of our Tot programs are taught by Parks & Recreation employees. This means you will not hear from a coach prior to the start date of the program. You can just show up at the appropriate place and time and we will be ready to help your child have fun!

Do you rent out canoes and kayaks?

We no longer rent out this equipment. The Tecumseh Paddling Company does though! You may reach them at 517-423-2700.

Do you offer swim lessons?

We do not facilitate the Tecumseh Community Pool. They can be reached at 517-423-5585.

My children attend Tecumseh Public Schools, why am I considered a Non-resident?

We based residency status on whether you pay city taxes. Only those living within the city limits are considered residents.

Can my child play down an age level for any of your sport programs?

We do not allow children to play down. Once your child has had their birthday and has reached a new age level before the start date of that specific program, we cannot allow them to play down with a younger team. This is to try our best to keep children of the same age, closeness of height and size together. This helps our teams to improve, grow, progress, and advance at a better pace. However, we do allow children move up an age group if the parents believe that their child has enough experience and is ready to play up with an older age level. Please be aware that camps and programs that are done in conjunction with other facilities and staff have the right to decide if they will allow children to play up an an age level.
