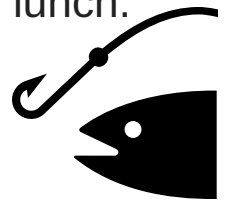


Kid's Fishing Derby!

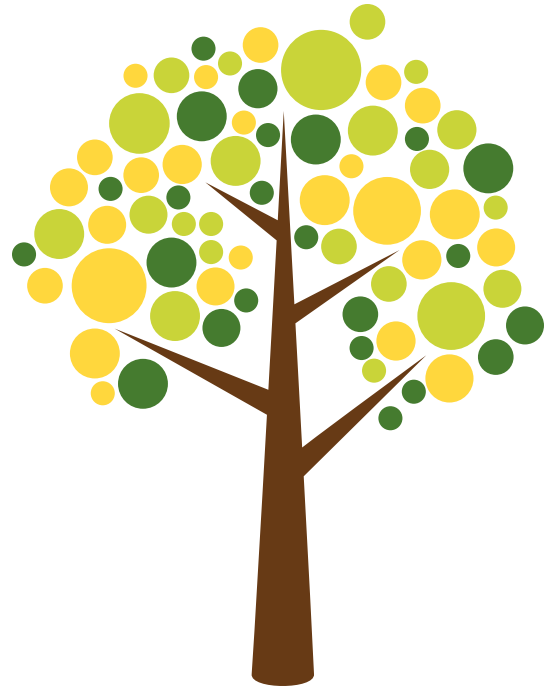

Race the River Run!

Join us at Globe Mill Pond for our Canoe and Kayak races held this year on Saturday, July 22. Separate heats for tandem kayaks, single kayaks, and canoes as teams of two and individuals tackle the River Raisin Run. This 3 mile looped water trail features two ponds, one raceway, a glorious stretch on the River Raisin, and several portages, including the challenging Globe Mill Hill! With prizes and bragging rights, you'll want to start training now! Races are for ages 16 and up.
