Tecumseh's Parks and Recreation department currently offers an after school drop-in program for youth 5th through 12th grade. The program is offered Monday through Thursday from 2:30 to 4:30 at the AJ Smith Recreation Center, located at 810 N. Evans Street, Tecumseh MI. Students are invited to enjoy the gymnasiums at the new recreation center. The cost for the program is \$1 per student each time they drop in (or they may purchase a punch card \$20 for 20 visits). The gyms are set up to accommodate a variety of activities including: basketball, indoor soccer, pickle ball, badminton and more. Arrangements must be made to pick up youth participants at 4:30 pm. This will allow Parks and Recreation staff to prepare the gyms for evening programs. If you would like your child to participate in the drop-in program, fill out the After School Drop - in Registration Form. This can be found on the left hand side of this page under Forms & Documents. **Youth will not be allowed to participate if we do not have a signed copy of this document.**

First Student, in conjunction with Tecumseh Public Schools, has generously offered to provide bus transportation for Tecumseh Middle School students to the AJ Smith Recreation Center for the Youth Drop-In program. **Parents/guardians must contact First Student Transportation and make arrangements for students to ride the bus. First Student Transportation can be reached at 517-423-2706. If arrangements are not made with First Student ahead of time, student will not be able to ride the bus from Tecumseh Middle School to the AJ Smith Recreation Center.**

To insure the success of the bussing program, please keep the following in mind:

Arrangements must be made for students to ride the bus from Tecumseh Middle School to the AJ Smith Recreation Center. Contact First Student at 517-423-2706.

Arrangements must be made to pick up middle school students at 4:30 pm from the AJ Smith Recreation Center. This will allow our staff to clean the gymnasiums and set up equipment for evening programs. City staff is unable to transport students home.

Parents/guardians and youth must fill out and sign the registration form.

This form must be returned to the Parks and Recreation Department. If we do not have this paperwork on file, youth will not be able to participate in the program.

Youth that chose to misbehave will be asked to leave and may not be able to participate in the future.
